### **DATA RECIPIENTS**

Processes connected to the web services of this site are handled only by people specially designated to this task. In case of need, the data can be processed by the company's personnel who take care of the site's technological part's maintenance: Well Com s.r.l., with registered office in Via rio Misureto n. 8 – 12051 Alba (CN), Italy.

### **TYPES OF DATA PROCESSED**

### 1. Web Browsing Data

During their normal operation, computer systems and software procedures used to operate this website acquire some personal data, the transmission of which is implicit in the use of internet communication protocols.

This information is not collected with the intent of associating it with identified users but, by its own very nature, could lead to the identification of users through processing and association with data held by third parties.

This category of data includes the IP addresses or domain names of computers used by users connecting to the website, the URI (Uniform Resource Identifier) of the resources requested, the time of the request, the method used to submit the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in reply, the numerical code indicating the status of the response from the server (successful, failed, etc.) and other parameters about the operating system and the computer environment.

These data are only used to obtain anonymous statistical data about the use of the Website and to check that it is functioning correctly; these data are deleted immediately after processing. The data could be used to ascertain responsibility in case of hypothetical computer crimes to the detriment of the website.

The legal basis of this processing is the legitimate interest of the Data Controller with the site's technical management so as to guarantee its functionality and security.

The navigation data, except for specific security issues or any need for criminal offenses to be ascertained by the judicial authorities, are maintained for possible technical analysis with regards to the site's functionality and security for a maximum period of 30 days. Once the above retention terms have expired, the data are destroyed, deleted or made anonymous, compatibly with the technical cancellation and backup procedures.

The legal basis of the processing is the performance of a contract to which you are party or the execution of precontractual measures, as well as the legitimate interest of the Data Controller to manage your requests or claims.

### 3. Cookies

As any website, also ours uses some cookies. Cookies are small text files that the websites visited by the user (but also other websites or web servers) send and save onto the user's computer (or mobile device). These are then retransmitted back to the same websites (or web servers) the next time they are visited, thus sending information.

Cookies are now fundamental tools as they allow modern sites to work at their best, allowing for maximum personalization, interaction and fluidity in browsing. But they can also be used to track user browsing and then send advertisements in line with those preferences.

Cookies can be:

- session cookies (if they expire when the browser is closed) or permanent (they remain until the end of a period, even years);

The Italian Supervisory Authority considers cookies to be technical if they are session cookies, functionality cookies or subject to certain conditions - analytics cookies particularly the Italian Supervisory Authority, in its decision of 8 May 2014, has specified that the latter may be treated as technical cookies only if they are used for optimization of the site by the owner of the site, who may collect aggregate information on the number of users and how they visit the site.
